2024 America Destroyed

A couple months later, people were putting their lives back together. Word had gotten out that Cap had predicted the Earthquake. Several of her friends made a date to meet her and hear what she thought would happen next. They met at Vito's, a small Italian restaurant off campus. What is going to happen to America, they asked her. Cap asked,

"Are you sure you want to hear this? It is not for the weak."

Theresa Neumann

Cap picked up a quote from Theresa Neumann. Neumann was a Bavarian who suffered the wounds of Jesus on Good Friday. Hitler wanted to kill her, but didn't risk the political cost of doing so. Cap was interested in one sentence which Teresa was supposed to have told visiting GI's after WWII. "The Bavarian stigmatist Theresa Neumann said that we will be punished by the elements. 'America's charity pleased God: America's kindness to those in need; her sharing her blessings with less fortunate members of the human race. As a reward, God would spare America the scourge of concentration camps, but He would bring Americans to their knees and away from sin, through the elements. "



Theresa said, 'He would purify our country with disturbances in nature, until Americans learned to do God's will and keep His Commandments.' So, this answers the question, what does God think about America. He loves us for our Charity. He will punish us for our immorality. And the method He will use will be natural calamities like earthquakes and tornados. It also implies that the government will be bankrupt and the people will be impoverished.

Theresa said that we would be spared concentration camps. That is a staggering phrase. It is as if Neumann is saying that events will be bad, but not as bad as having concentration camps, but close. It is hard to imagine what kind of world she is describing.

There is an Optimism Bias in human nature. I do not think that people are prepared for how bad this could get.

"I have studied the Fatima documents for years and I have only found one reference to America by Sister Lucy." She opened a book. Here is what Frere Michel wrote: 'On May 14, 1953, Sister Lucy received an American, Martin F. Armstrong, in the Carmel parlor. It seems that he wanted to obtain a 'special message' from her for the peoples of the United States. This made the Mother Prioress laugh, and even the seer it seems. "No", she told him, "Our Lady has not communicated to me any special message for the people of the United States. She has never mentioned the name of your country." ⁱ

'As Mr. Armstrong insisted, Sister Lucy, after a moment's reflection, replied: "I have nothing to say that is extraordinary or sensational. And what I do have to say will not be judged very clever or popular, I fear. One of the things particularly asked for by Our Lady was modesty in one's clothing. It seems to me that there is not a lot of modesty in the lives of the women of your country. But modesty would be a good sacrifice to offer Our Lady. If the Catholics of your country could form a league to spread modesty in clothing, that would greatly please Our Lady." '

Cap told her listeners that this was right after WWII when America was on the top of the world. Armstrong was no doubt surprised that America had not been mentioned.

Cap went on. "Although Lucy had nothing to say about America, there is evidence elsewhere. These could be the last days of America as we know it. A case can made that America will be largely destroyed in the next ten years. She has already been divided in two and large areas have been submerged. The coasts will be struck with more tidal waves. The land will be ripped by more earthquakes. There will be terrific storms, tornadoes, hurricanes, floods, diseases, pestilence and crop failures.

At Fatima, Our Lady said "nations will be annihilated". Lucy said that many nations will disappear. Since you have asked for it, I will present my case that more trouble is coming."

Some will be Annihilated

Lucy said that Jesus told her that "The time is coming when the rigor of My Justice will punish the crimes of diverse nations. Some of them will be annihilated. At last, the severity of My Justice will fall severely on those who want to destroy My Reign in souls." It is a matter of importance that both Jesus and Mary expressed the idea that nations will be annihilated.

Cap said that "Both the east and west coasts of our country have reason to fear the severity of justice. The east coast has been the home of an atheistic and materialistic culture that sought to de-Christianize America and the world. The west coast is home to a media culture which glamorizes sexual sin and seduces youth everywhere across the planet. These two areas could be reasonably placed high on a list of those who sought to supplant the reign of Jesus in the hearts of men.

The middle part of America may hope to be spared the worst. But still it will face storms, earthquakes and diseases.

America Largely Submerged.

St Hildegard tells of America being divided and submerged. The coasts will be pounded by tidal waves. Hildegard said '[After the] great Comet, the great nation will be devastated by earthquakes, storms, and great waves of water, causing much want and plagues. The ocean will also flood many other countries, so that all coastal cities will live in fear, with many destroyed.

'All sea coast cities will be fearful, and many of them will be destroyed by tidal waves, and most

living creatures will be killed, and even those who escape will die from a horrible disease. For in none of those cities does a person live according to the Laws of God.

Cap said "Hildegard singled out the coastal cities as being the hardest hit. It seems that she takes a dim view of the people who inhabit the coasts."



The Good Excepted.

Cap looked at her guests and said

"Hildegard used the expression 'the good excepted.' Hildegard said that 'Before the Comet comes, many nations, the good excepted, will be scourged with want and famine.' One may reasonably ask who are 'the good excepted' and where are they. I wonder myself but I would guess it is the good people of middle America. The last part of that sentence uses the word famine. Can you imagine the conditions in which America would have famine?".

Whole Sections of Continents will Disappear.

Malachi Martin read the Third Secret when he was an assistant to Cardinal Bea in the 1960's. He said in an interview that whole sections of continents will disappear. It was a written interview. He had time to correct it if it did not correctly express his view. The question is, from what source did he get this information? I suspect that he had the opportunity to read some of Sister Lucy's notebooks."

A few days later, Cap mused with a friend. "Most apocalyptic stories follow the same pattern. First comes an apocalyptic event which is covered briefly. Then most of the book is about the aftermath. There is an abundance of post-apocalyptic books.

The picture which emerges from catholic prophecy is just the opposite. First comes a long period of tribulations; the difficulties. Then the peak apocalyptic event. And then a time of peace and goodwill. Alois said it will be a happy time. And, after a year or two of scarcity, sausages will fall off the plate. There will be order, justice, a great monarch and many subordinate kings.

For America, there is good news and bad news. Our situation may be different than Europe's. If you put all the pieces together, it looks like America gets punished early, but may do better afterwards.

Here is the reasoning: First, Alois and Von Werdenberg said that New York will be destroyed early in the time of difficulties by a nuclear explosion. Life seems to go on in Europe.

Secondly, a great sign will light up the sky. It will be a catastrophe. It may be a solar storm which melts down our electrical grid. Hildegard said more earthquakes. Melanie Porzat said there will be inclemency's of weather and inundations. As the weather changes, farm production will suffer.

Thirdly, if you look at Chapter Eight in Apocalypse, America gets hit harder than Europe in the early years.

The first trumpet is fire from the sky. Although it strikes Russia hardest, all green grass and crops will be burned up.

The second trumpet is a mountain that falls in the Atlantic and inundates the east coast.

The third trumpet strikes Quebec and poisons the Great Lakes.

The fourth trumpet punishes the whole world with darkness. The focus then shifts toward Europe with the beginning of civil war.

On the good side, America might be spared a civil war. At the end of hostilities, the pope will return from across the sea. Conditions may be hospitable enough in America that we might be the place he returns from.

Survival Only in the Country

Speaking mostly about Germany, Von Werdenberg said that survival will be possible only in the country and in small villages. The chances of survival may be better in the country in America than in Europe.
