2030 Pestilence

Diseases were taking a toll on the population. People began dying of exhaustion and stress. Through most of March, the weather had been unusually cold. The toppled buildings of St Louis, the broken windows, the buildings without heat, the hunger, the disease and disorder had all combined to take a toll on Cap and the people around her. There were so many discouraged people who were sick. The strain of working in the midst of so many difficulties finally caught up with Cap. She caught a cold. She needed a change of scene.

Cap's friend, Alice, invited her to take a break and visit her again. Cap loved Alice's small farm on the outskirts of Fulton. She loved to walk through Alice's property. Cap liked to browse through the small garden and trek through the orchard and pasture. On warm days, she liked to sit on the pier and dangle her feet over the lake and watch the little fishes come by. If she were in the mood for a long walk, she would set off for the woods and visit her favorite trees.

Alice had a spare bedroom in the back-right corner of the house. On the back wall of that bedroom was a large window. From the window, one could see the backyard, the garden and the woods. The Madonna specified that the leaves were to be steeped in boiling water for 14 minutes within a covered container. ⁱ

Cap suffered severely for three days, then her symptoms began to lessen. Slowly Cap recovered. After ten days, she was able to sit up in bed. After two weeks, she was able to get out of bed and walk to the kitchen.

After Cap recovered

After another week had passed, Cap felt well enough to go out into the yard. Cap leaned over and touched the grass. She felt its texture. She ran her hand slowly through the grass one way and then another. It seemed to her that there was a harmony between the breeze which swayed the branches of the apples trees and the hand which swept the grass.

While recovering, Cap read *Comets of God* by an archeologist named Jeffrey Goodman. He believed that the last three trumpets of the Apocalypse would be worse the the first four. And, each would be more severe and destructive than the one before. One day, Cap sat bundled up

on the patio. As she basked in the early spring sunshine, she pondered Goodman's interpretation of the fifth trumpet. The eagle said in a loud voice: "Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth." A star will fall from heaven and create a deep crater. From the crater come locusts and pestilence which will torment men for five months. But only those who had not the seal of God on their foreheads. ^{III} Goodman thought that the comet would bring bacteria.

Cap was concerned. She had seen the back cover of one of Goodman's other book, "We are the Earthquake Generation". It



showed a map of America in which the west was submerged. There was a big area inundated in the middle west, including most of Colorado. She wondered if this was the deep crater of the Fifth Trumpet.

Alice came out to sit beside Cap and Cap shared her thoughts. Alice asked how it was that men would suffer from the locusts for five months but not those who had the seal of God on their foreheads. Cap did not know the answer to that question.

2030 Russia The Ratchet

When Cap returned to campus in May, she sat down in the faculty lounge with the head of her department, Frank Roberts. Roberts had had an interest in Cap's writings since the beginning. "What do you think is going to happen next." Cap, "I have a respect for Malachi Martin. He had seen the Third Secret. And yet, he never revealed the contents of the secret. He could have been called "the man who kept a secret".

"One of the lines which I never understood was one about the ratchet. He said that 'In fact, the physical and spiritual chastisements, according to Lucia's letter, are to be gridded on a fateful timetable in which Russia is the ratchet.' Then one day it came to me. A ratchet is a device which moves in one linear direction. It moves from one position to the next position. One after another. If Russia is the ratchet, it means that when Russia makes its move, other events will follow like dominos. It started in 1917. Mary had mentioned Russia by name in the July apparition.

Russia's first move was to get the Pope indicted. She is the power behind the scenes. She has begun to make her move. She wants to quietly eliminate the Church because she fears the Church. The Church is the single point around which the opposition could rally.

What will happen this year is that the socialist revolution will gather momentum. The economic crisis will deepen. Unemployment will increase. The Left and the Greens will gather votes. Civil war will break out late this year or next.

Cap handed Roberts a paper. The title read "The Ratchet". Roberts spent a couple minutes skimming the paper Cap had composed. Cap told him that "the following excerpts were taken from Keys of the Blood by Malachi Martin.

The Ratchet

The paper read as follows: "Lucia's single-page written formulation of the "Third Secret" covers three main topics. A physical chastisement of the nations, involving catastrophes, man-made or natural, on land, on water and in the atmosphere of the globe. A spiritual chastisement, far more frightening and distressing - especially for Roman Catholics - than physical hardship, since it would consist of the disappearance of religious belief, a period of widespread unfaith in many countries. A central function



of Russia in the two-preceding series of events. In fact, the physical and spiritual chastisements, according to Lucia's letter, are to be gridded on a fateful timetable in which Russia is the ratchet.

Punishment for Abandonment of God's laws

Roberts went on reading from Martin's book. "The chastisements were meant to punish the nations for their ungodliness and abandonment of God's laws. The whole dire process could be averted - need not happen, in fact - if two requests of Mary were granted. One: that whoever would be Pope in 1960 (actually it was John XXIII) should publish the text of the "Third Secret" for the whole world to read and know. Two: that then the Pope, with all his bishops acting collegially, should consecrate Russia to Mary. Russia, according to the text of the "Third Secret," was the regulator of the timetable.

If those two basic requests were satisfied, then the two chastisements physical and spiritual would not be inflicted on mankind. Russia would be converted to religious belief, and a period of great peace and prosperity would ensue. If the requests were denied, the chastisements would then follow as surely as night follows day. Russia would spread its errors throughout all nations. Many millions would die. The practice of religion and the profession of true faith would diminish to a shadow of what they were. Widespread corruption would infect the Church's clergy and laity. The Holy Father would have much to suffer. A little glimmer of hope existed: in the end, after all this dreadful devastation, there would be a restoration of faith and tolerable living conditions. "

Unmistakably, the 'Third Secret' was formulated as an ultimatum, an 'either-or' proposition.

In 1978, shortly after becoming Pope, when John Paul II read Lucia's text of the "Third Secret," he had drawn the obvious conclusion. The Pope of 1960, John XXIII, had not satisfied those two requests of Mary. "These (predictions)," John had noted for his successors, "do not concern our times." John had refused to publish the text of the "Third Secret." He had not organized the collegial consecration of Russia to Mary - although he had a made-to-order opportunity to do so when 2,500 Roman Catholic bishops assembled in the Vatican Council. He did not accept the "either."

Therefore, the fateful timetable of spiritual and physical chastisements was locked into place and, in that August of 1981, was running full tilt.

Most frighteningly for John Paul, he had come up against the irremovable presence of a malign strength in his own Vatican and in certain bishop's chanceries.

Too Late to Reform

More Malachi Martin. "John Paul's answers to the questioners at the 1980 Fulda meeting also threw light on why he has not undertaken any serious, papal-directed and comprehensive effort to reverse the continual and rapid deterioration of his institutional organization. No, he said in response to one question, the Church cannot be reformed at the present moment."

Manifestly, John Paul II had accepted the fait accompli that inevitably followed the decision of John XXIII not to follow the dictates of the "Third Secret." He accepted the fact that the Church was now in the period of the Fatima "or," since the "either" had been refused by John XXIII."

Cap told Roberts that the pope believed the situation in Europe would steadily deteriorate.

Red Flag

As spring turned to summer, the troubles in European society increased. Cap told a friend, "In this year, we can expect to see the beginnings of civil war, which Jahenny spoke about. And eventually, Russia will raise her flag over the dome of St Peter's.



My Heart is breaking

Jahenny said that Jesus told her 'My Heart is breaking. I seek pure souls to transpierce with the sword that pierced Mine at the First Passion. All these swords will pierce one by one the victims of Jesus. Suffering is necessary, crosses are necessary. It will be so terrible that it will be unbearable to live on earth. Martyr after martyr, cruelty after cruelty, tyrant after tyrant, stake upon stake, tyranny upon tyranny.'"

The friend asked "stake upon stake, what does that mean"? I suppose it means that in the madness, people will be impaled. In the Armenian genocide, Christians were impaled.

Three-quarters will perish

"Jahenny said that 'Three-quarters of the population of the globe will disappear in the last crisis. Terrible earthquakes, epidemics of unknown diseases whose ravages would be frightful, terrible famines, inclement weather, cyclones, rising seas that would cause terrifying tidal waves."

Obsessed and Possessed

Cap said that "Jahenny also announced that at the time of the last crisis 'a large number of souls will be obsessed and possessed by the infernal spirit and to exorcise these souls, a great number of penances and mortifications will be required from the Fathers of the Church that Heaven will subject to this harsh trial.'

'Many Souls will be possessed a few months before the crisis... The world will be mad with fear... The devil ... will make them deny their baptism and the Cross.'

Three Crises

Jahenny said that The Last Crisis will have three parts. I will tell you what she said and then my interpretation. The first crisis will be 'long and painful when divine vengeance will be manifested during which the guiltiest will be destroyed... The second will be shorter but more formidable... seeing all these blows cannot bring His people to pardon.

The third, everything must be lost from top to bottom... St Michael will descend with his armies to fight along with my good children.

When everything seems lost... Then will be the time of victory. It will be the time when all the crimes and impieties fall back on those who committed them.

It will be in this third crisis that Salvation will come.

Here is my interpretation of the Crises. The First Crisis, long and painful, is that which we have experienced between 2023 and 2029. The storm, the earthquake, the catastrophe and the first four trumpets.



The second crisis began in 2029 and will end just before the Three

Days Darkness. It will be the Civil War and WWIII. Jahenny said that God saw that these blows would not bring mankind back to his senses to ask for pardon.

The Third Crisis, when everything must be lost from Top to Bottom, will be the Three Days Darkness. All will be lost. All that has been made by the hand of man will be crushed, as if it were lifted into the air and thrown down. The earth will be like a vast cemetery. 'The bodies of the wicked and the just will cover the ground.' The survivors will think they are alone on earth.

Jahenny said that "God will strike in an unprecedented way. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth! God will exhaust His wrath upon them, and no one will be able to escape so many afflictions together." I believe that we have entered the dark hours of her prophecies. From here on out, it will be a bumpy ride.

Auxvasse

In June of 2030, Cap purchased a home a half hour north of Fulton outside a little country town

of 1000 souls named Auxvasse. She had a small house and about ten acres, half in pasture and in half woods. It was approached by a sunken road. It had a small shed, a garden, and a well. It gave her what she wanted. Plenty of wood for a wood stove. Plenty of room for a garden. Room to plant an orchard. Fresh water. And a small pond.



West Vulnerable.

In June, writing from her new house, Cap sent out a newsletter. She said that Martin had a solid grasp of the sweep of history. He felt that the West could be entrapped by Russia.

Martin wrote in Keys of This Blood that "In that Third Secret, indeed, Lucia's words are so explicit and so verifiable- and therefore so authentic- that, were the leaders of the Leninist Party-State to know those words, they would in all probability decide to undertake certain territorial and militaristic moves against which the West could have few if any means of resisting, and the Church would be plunged into further and deeper subjugation to the Party-State. Lucia's words underline a terrible vulnerability in the capitalist nations. That is the "seriousness" of Lucia's words. The capitalist West could be entrapped by the USSR. In Vatican parlance, Lucia's words have a dire geopolitical meaning. They must not be treated as pious and devotional outpourings. Her words from the Fatima happening are primarily related to the fierce politics of nations."

Cap wrote that the Third Secret was unusually political. The Madonna came down hard against Russia. In fact, in World War II, Pius XII had been persuaded to tone down the known parts of the Second part of the Secret. The Madonna warned against Russia. She did not mention

Germany. The Madonna said: "When you see a night illuminated by an unknown light, know that this is the great sign that God gives that He is about to punish the world by means of war, hunger, and persecution of the Church and of the Holy Father. To prevent this, I will come to ask for the Consecration of Russia to My Immaculate Heart and the Communion of Reparation on the First Saturdays.



Nations will be Annihilated.

"If people will attend to my requests, Russia will be converted and there will be peace. If not, Russia will spread its errors throughout the world, fomenting wars and persecution of the Church. The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will have much to suffer, and various nations will be annihilated. In the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to Me. It will be converted and a certain period of peace will be granted to the world."

It was clear that in the eyes of the Madonna, Russia was the great enemy. It was feared that if the condemnation of Russia became know, it would tilt opinion against Russia and would scuttle Roosevelt's plans to make an alliance with Russia. The whole post war history of Eastern Europe might have been different.

Green Light.

John Paul II feared that if the Russians knew that the Third Secret predicted that Russia would succeed in invading Europe, then they would consider that to be a green light on their invasion plans. It would rally their own forces and their allies in Europe.

Irresistible.

John Paul II felt that the European nations were ill equipped to deal with a Russian military assault. The Russians had supported the peace parties of Europe. As a result, the Europeans were militarily much weaker than the Russians. One seer had predicted that the Russians would pounce on Europe like unprotected game. Russia was mobilized. Europe was not. The Russians, on their side, had no peace parties to deal with.

Cap closed her newsletter on a note of hope. She reminded her readers that although there were rough times ahead, in the end the world would be a better place. She quoted Martin again. "It will be the death and entombment of Leninist Marxism and the effective liquidation of the long - centuries long - war that forces of this civilized world have waged against the Church Christ founded and the religious belief of that Church. The battle between the Gospel and the anti-Gospel will be over."

Cap continued. "The Madonna Herself had predicted a happy ending. 'In the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph. Russia will be consecrated. It will be converted and a certain period of peace will be granted to the world.'"

Goodman speaks about Russia

That evening in the Officers' Club, Goodman talked about Russia. He said that after fire fell from the sky on Russia, many of the Russians fled as refugees to Europe. Their cities were burned. Their fields and farms were burned. They had nothing to go back to. They preferred Germany. The merchant class welcomed the exodus. Many of the wealthy came, buying goods. It set up a buying spree. German merchants were glad to see the boost in their sales. They bought properties, too, which propped up the real estate market."

The Demographic Winter.

It was the answer to a prayer. The European birth dearth had left the Europeans in the position that there were not enough young people to take over the positions and pay the taxes to support an aging population. The Europeans were relying increasingly on Moslems, which given the high birth rate among Moslems, meant one day the Moslems would be a majority. That Russians were pouring into Germany, seemed to solve that problem.

Baden Baden

Goodman had a friend who lived in Baden Baden, along the border of France. It had attracted many well to do Russians. They called Baden Baden the California of Germany. The Russians felt more comfortable with the Germans than with the French.



Long plan.

The Russian military quickly saw the opportunity. They had never given up the idea of dominating Europe and the world. Each class of officers was indoctrinated that their goal was to use force to achieve the great world socialist revolution. They sent soldiers among the refugees. They infiltrated and bankrolled the Green Party. They would get them to shut down the nuclear reactors. Russian oil would fill the gaps. Russian natural gas companies would supply the gas. Russian pipeline companies would transport the natural gas. Russian construction companies would build the refineries. Russian trucking companies would distribute the fuel and gasoline. The Russian companies would have German names and in many cases be German companies but they would be owned by consortiums which were controlled by the KBG.

The funds would allow the takeovers of many other related industries, even utilities. Russians would take positions in the telecommunications security services. They took over bus companies and trucking. They infiltrated the police.

The executive superstructure of these companies was permeated with KBG personnel. Many of the workers would be ordinary Russians, but many were soldiers, ex-soldiers and members of the Russian National Guard. They would conduct themselves like the American National Guard. They would train as soldiers one weekend a month and one month a year.

Some Europeans were alarmed at the number of Russian quest workers who were Russian Guard members. But the Russians explained that the high cost of living made it necessary for the guest workers to earn extra income and that it was a temporary condition. When the solar panels and windmills kicked in, the EU wouldn't need the Russians and they would go back home. But the day would come when the Russian guest workers would implement the long plan. They would seize the intersections, shut down the power and stop communications. As Russian tanks and busses and trucks poured into Europe, Europe would sleep. Hap looked into his glass with a faraway look. "The Chinese have joined the Russians and are making open preparations for war."

Decapitate the US

"There was a Bush administration Counterintelligence officer named Brenner. He testified that the Russians have launched an intensive assault to penetrate the upper echelon of U.S. decision-making. Brenner said that "Moscow already has enough knowledge of the U.S. government's internal mechanisms to decapitate the country's leadership in the event of war."

Food scarce and expensive

Cap rode her bicycle into town to get a few supplies. She heard that food prices had risen again. When she returned home, she looked at her notes.

Food shortages

Jahenny wrote that "The famine will be great... Everything will be thrown into confusion". The Ecstatic of Tours wrote that food would be scarce and expensive.

2030 Jahenny reviewed

Cap reviewed her notes about the mystic Julia Jahenny. She was perhaps the greatest stigmatist in the history of the Church. She was a virgin clairvoyant and a holy person. Jahenny said that "those who govern the Flock", will be responsible for the coming crisis. Apparently, Communism would not have triumphed if the Church had remained faithful. She mentions the growing freedom enjoyed by priests and bishops and how badly they will use it.

Jahenny mentions a Pope who, at the last moment, will reverse his policies and make a solemn appeal to the Clergy. But he will not be obeyed; on the contrary, an Assembly of Bishops will demand even greater freedom, declaring that they will no longer obey the Pope.

Marie Julie goes on to say that the Red Revolution will then break out. She speaks of a "horrible religion" which is to replace the Catholic Faith, and she sees "many, many bishops" embracing this "sacrilegious, infamous religion."

Fatal Event

Jahenny spoke of the times leading up to the "Fatal Event". The Madonna spoke to her. "If My Divine Son and I were to work miracles greater than all the ones in Judea, than all the miracles of the past, all these marvels would be scorned. They would further insult My Divine Son and His Holy Mother. In short, it is a blindness. It is an infernal veil woven by the enemy jealous of the marvels and the power of my Divine Son."

I will Decimate the People

Jahenny had a vision of a dialogue between Our Lord and Lucifer, and the latter said "I will attack the Church. I will overthrow the Cross, I will decimate the people, I will deposit a great weakness of faith in hearts. There will also be a great denial of religion.

I will be Master of all things

"For a time, I will be Master of all things, everything will be under my control, even Your temple and all Your people."

Satan will triumph for a time.

Saint Michael says that Satan will have possession of everything for some time and that he will reign completely over everything; that all goodness, Faith, Religion will be buried in the tomb. . . Satan and his own will triumph with joy, but after this triumph, the Lord will in His turn gather His own people and will reign and triumph over evil and will raise up from the tomb the buried Church, the prostrated Cross. . . "And the Head of the Heavenly Armies adds "Here is my

Fiery Sword. I want to lend to the friends of the Sacred Heart and offer them this sword for the fight because the time is not far off when all of you faithful people will have to take up the arms of Faith and Courage to fight against the relentless pursuit of hell and the vengeance of men.

The greater number of priests will turn to the side of evil. Our Lady said this time had to come for them, because there had to be a reign of evil on earth before the Divine Reign.

New Mass Odious in My Sight

Our Lord and Our Lady announced the conspiracy to invent the "New Mass". "I give you a warning. The disciples who are not of My Gospel are now working hard to remake according to their ideas and under the influence of the enemy of souls a Mass that contains words that are Odious in My sight."

Fatal Hour

"When the Fatal Hour arrives, when the faith of my priests is put to the test... The enemies of the Faith and of Holy Religion (will impose their formulas)" on the Mass. These infamous spirits are those who crucified Me and are awaiting the kingdom of the new messiah."

"In their [priests] aberration, they will break their oaths. The Book of Life contains a list of names that 'rends the heart.' ... "Because of the little respect it has for the apostles of God, the flock grows careless and ceases to observe the laws. The priest himself is responsible for the lack of respect because he does not respect enough his holy ministry, and the place which he occupies in his sacred functions. The flock follows in the footsteps of its pastors; this is a great tragedy."
