2032 Revolution, War and the Consecration of Russia

After putting a couple logs in the stove, Cap sat down at her desk to prepare a January forecast. She looked out at the stubble of corn in the field next door. In the early morning sunlight, a blanket of snow clung to the roots. Low in the horizon, the sun peaked through the treetops and illuminated the landscape.

Cap had decided to stay in place for most of the winter. She was warm. She had plenty of wood.



She wasn't afraid of theft for a couple reasons. One was that her nearest neighbor could see her house and kept an eye on it. Another was that everyone in her neighborhood knew everyone else. Strangers or wanderers were not welcome.

Early on, the different localities had set up roadblocks. As soon as a car exited the highway, they had to check in and get a pass. No one was allowed to travel without a pass. And no one was allowed off the main roads without permission. As a result, almost no one was allowed in. Once in a while, they would come across a random car, and the stranger would need to go into town to sign in and later to sign out. Their cars were checked and their contents noted. Sometimes, the traveler was held overnight while their story was checked out.

Cap left the back door unlocked when she was away because glass had become too expensive. If someone wanted to break in, they would break the backdoor or the glass. The wisdom of the neighborhood was that a lock wouldn't stop them.

Her neighbor lived on the far side of a corn field which separated their properties. He had a line of sight view of her house. His nickname was Guns. Guns had come over and put a bell on her roof. He ran a cord to her bedroom. He told her to ring the bell if she should ever need help. He bagged up a lot of her canned foods and carried them to the edge of the woods. He gave her some plastic buckets, and together they buried a dozen five-gallon buckets of canned goods. He told her that you can't be without food. She kept one year's supply of canned goods in the forest. She didn't eat much, so she didn't have to bury a lot. Cap had been fairly successful with gardening. A couple years earlier, another neighbor had invited Cap to garden alongside her. The ground was already tilled. Cap learned how to grow food and do things with a garden that she had never imagined. The neighbor was full of

information and had a lot of heirloom seeds. Cap harvested more than she ever thought possible. Cap left the onions, cabbages, potatoes and carrots in the ground till the first frost. The neighbor showed her how to build a natural cold storage system in the ground. They dug out deep holes and put the winter foods into them and covered them with straw. The son promised to watch over them. He was a good shot.

Government quotas.

The larger farms were put under quota. They were obligated

to sell their corn to the government. The government in turn issued ration cards. The smaller farms were exempt. As a homestead of less than ten acres of arable land, Cap was relatively free to keep as much as she could grow. The garden neighbor had agreed to plant her eight acres in return for eighty per cent of the produce. It was a good deal for Cap. She still could harvest her private garden of one acre to keep her hand in the business of growing and canning.

Cap Says Goodbye to her apartment.





Cap returned to her apartment in March to gather some remaining items. She did not think she would see her apartment again. She packed all she could take into a friend's van. She took one more walk to the balcony. She looked at the cracked dome of the Cathedral and across the skyline of North St Louis. Wisps of smoke rose here and there across the horizon. She said good bye to this place, and this view and the many good things which she had had in her life there.

Cap remembered the days not long ago when she would come home from work, put on a robe, pour herself a glass of wine and call downstairs for the restaurant to send up a favorite dish. But, that was another world. Those days had now passed away.

Speech at the University

The next day, Cap met with a small group from the university who wanted to hear her forecast. They met in the basement of the University Church. Her podium stood almost directly below the point in the Celestory of the sacristy where St Michael had appeared at the conclusion of the famous exorcism.

Seventh Trumpet and the Seventh Bowl

Cap began by referring to the Seventh Trumpet and the Seventh Bowl. She read from Apocalypse 16. "Then there came flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder and a severe earthquake. No earthquake like it has ever occurred since mankind has been on earth, so tremendous was the quake. "

God's Wrath

God remembered Babylon the Great and gave her the cup filled with the wine of the fury of his wrath.

The Temple of God was opened in Heaven

Cap continued. "I will give you the literal version of the end of the Seventh Trumpet and then my version in common speech.



Here is what is written in the Douay-Rheims version of the Bible: 'And the temple of God was opened in heaven: and the ark of his testament was seen in his temple, and there were lightnings, and voices, and an earthquake, and great hail.' This is the end of Chapter 11. The next sentence in chapter 12 is 'And a great sign appeared in heaven: A woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.' The Bible did not get chapters until the twelfth century. Originally, these sentences were written in succession. If the above sentences are expressed in common speech, the passage would read like this: 'In the midst of lightnings, and voices, and an earthquake and a great hail, the temple of heaven opened and the ark of the covenant was seen. A Great Sign appeared in heaven. A woman clothed with the Sun. With the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.' The scene will cause fear and dread.

Sister Lucy was once asked about the contents of the Third Secret. She said to read Apocalypse chapters eight through thirteen. See the Douay-Rheims version drbo.org.

Mountains leveled

Cap continued reading from Apocalypse. "And every island disappeared, and all the mountains were leveled.

Hundred-pound hailstones

"From the sky huge hailstones, each weighing about a hundred pounds, fell on people. And they cursed God on account of the plague of hail, because the plague was so terrible."

Cap referred to Jeffrey Goodman, who wrote *Comets of God*. He believed that the Seventh Trumpet and the Seventh Bowl refer to a very large comet impact. It will be proceeded by a rain of hailstones, each which weight about one talent, which is a 100 pounds. The comet impact will cause an earthquake which will be the greatest since men have walked on the planet.



Goodman believed that a large meteor will penetrate the interior of the earth and explode. The heat released will cause the mantle to soften and melt. The mountain chains will sink. The shock would cause a Richter scale 14 earthquake which will crisscross the surface of the earth with faults and deep cracks. All the cities will shake and fall down. Islands will flee from sight. Mountains will sink.

Cap told the audience that we will have trouble from the skies and trouble from the world of men. She believed that Russia would invade Europe and plunge the world in World War III. "The subject of the War is outside the purview of my work. But I would like to treat it briefly.

There was a strong peace movement. Many had hope that peace was at hand. Cap did not. I believe that the Russians will strike before the Consecration to maximize their gains. It is their best chance at pulling of stopping the Consecration. If you would like to know more, I would suggest you look at the work of two Germans. One is Alois Irlmaier. Another is Gottfried von Werdenberg.

Here is a rough outline of events congruent with some of the modern prophecies.

Russian Military Takeover

Alois said that everyone will be saying peace, Schalom. Werdenberg said that the Russian Military leaders will take over power in Russia before World War III. We can see this taking shape in front of us.



There is a grand settlement in the making, which will provide for a Pax Europa, which will include Russia. There will be a diminishing role for the Russian military and a gradual conversion to a peacetime economy. But, the military will not go along. They will stage a coup. They will gamble that they can rule not only Russia, but also all of Europe. For a while, it will look like they are succeeding.

War in August

Alois was a humble Bavarian well digger. A number of his predictions have come to pass. He believed that the War would begin in August. 'The Third World War will come ... It will be preceded by signs in the skies, which will be seen by millions of people. War will begin on a rainy night, shortly before harvest time, when the ears are full... An invasion from the East will follow..."

Three Wedges Russian Blitzkrieg

Alois foresaw that the Russians would attack Europe suddenly and unexpectedly at a time when many thought that peace was at hand. He foresaw that the Russians would attack in three wedges. The main thrust across central Europe. A second attack



across northern Europe and a third attack across southern Europe.

Red Flag over St Peter's

There was a holy nun in Italy at the time of World War II named Sister Elena Aiello. She advised Mussolini to avoid an alliance with Hitler. Unfortunately, he did not follow her advice. Sister Aiello had frequent visions and had the stigmata.

Aiello foresaw the Russian invasion of Europe. The Madonna said to her 'Russia will march upon all the nations of Europe, particularly Italy, and will raise her flag over the dome of St. Peter's.' 'The river Rhine will be overflowing with corpses and blood. Italy will also be harassed by a great revolution, and the Pope will suffer terribly.'

Russia attacks America

Aiello foresaw that in WWIII, Russia would attack America at the same time at which Russia invades Europe. Sister Aiello said 'If people do not return to God with truly Christian living, another terrible war will come from the East to the West. Russia with her secret armies will battle America; will overrun Europe.' In all of the prophecies which I have found, this is the one which most clearly indicates that Russia will attack America."

Secret Armies.

The bad news is that Aiello had her feet on the ground. She was unusually reliable. I am sorry to tell you this, but the handwriting is on the wall. If Aiello said 'secret armies', then that implies that Russia is sending covert agents into America as businessmen and tourists and refugees. And, has probably been doing so for some time. When the times comes, they will rise up and shred our infrastructure.



American Retaliates

Alois foresaw that when the Russians invaded Europe, the Americans would retaliate. He said, 'Immediately the revenge comes from across the large water.'

China invades Alaska and Canada

Alois continued, 'However, the yellow dragon invades in Alaska and Canada at the same time. But he comes not far.' Alois is saying that the Chinese will attack Alaska and Canada when the Russians attack Europe. The plan to do so will have been worked out years earlier. They will have some initial success, but they will be defeated. "

New York destroyed

Alois also said that New York would be destroyed. 'The "Great City" of the United States will be destroyed by rockets, and the West Coast will be invaded by Asians, but they will be beaten back...' Werdenberg also forecast the destruction of New York.

Alois foresaw a bloody persecution in Italy. He said that 'Also in Italy it will be very bad. All priests except six will be murdered. The Pope will flee.'

The Consecration of Russia

After broaching the subject of the War in America, Cap took a break. She had lived with the idea so long that she had become accustomed to it. But, it was hard for some people to hear it for the first time. It came as a shock. A couple people were quietly weeping. Some were pale. Others took it in stride.

After the break, Cap began "Of the events which could happen in 2032, I think that the Consecration is the one which can most reliably be expected. It is anchored in the words of Jesus to Sister Lucy a hundred years earlier. It is the most predictable event of 2032. The other events can be derived from the consecration.

Here is the quote from Sister Lucy. 'Later on, by means of an interior communication, Our Lord complainingly said to me: "They did not want to heed My request. Like the King of France, they will repent and do so, but it will be late. Russia will already have spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The Holy Father will have much to suffer.' "

Like the King of France.



The use of the words 'like the King of France' is important. It implies

that Jesus will do as He did with the King of France. Here again is the rule of one hundred years. He said this around 1932. One can reasonably expect that because He said this in 1932, it will come to pass in 2032. And, it fits."

So, in 2032, the Consecration will be done. But, it will be late. Too late to prevent the war and the persecution of the Church.

One member of the audience asked, 'What happens after the Consecration?' Cap said "If you look back at the words of Mary, you will see. The Madonna told Lucy at the end of the third apparition that the Holy Father would consecrate Russia. It would be converted, and a certain period of peace would be granted to the world. This would constitute the Triumph of Her Immaculate Heart. Here are Her words, 'The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will have much to suffer, and various nations will be annihilated. In the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to Me. It will be converted and a certain period of peace will be granted to the world.' "The way I read this is that after the Pope has consecrated Russia, then there will be a conversion and counter revolution in Russia. It will undermine the Russian forces fighting in Europe. The Russian invasion will then fall apart. And, a period of peace will follow. The good news is that we are approaching the end of our troubles.

Annihilation of nations

Someone in the front row asked, "What about the annihilation of nations." Cap answered that "In the Madonna's description to Lucy, the annihilation precedes the Consecration. Therefore, the annihilation will occur this year. If we have the greatest earthquake of the seventh trumpet, the earth will tend to level out and flood many nations. Lucy said that many nations will disappear.

Spiritual Climate

Cap said that before she closed, she would like to touch on the spiritual climate of the times ahead of us.

Confusion everywhere

Marie-Julie Jahenny said that 'there will not remain any ... apparent trace of faith. Confusion will be everywhere...' "

The Mass shall cease to exist for a time.

Jahenny said that 'All the works approved by the infallible Church will cease to exist as they are today for a time. In this sorrowful annihilation, brilliant signs will be manifested on earth. If because of the wickedness of men Holy Church will be in darkness, the Lord will also send darkness that will stop the wicked in their search of wickedness..."


The general atmosphere reminded Cap of another quote by Jahenny. Saint Michael told Jahenny that "Satan would have



possession of everything for some time and that he would reign completely over everything; that all goodness, Faith, Religion will be buried in the tomb... Satan and his own will triumph with joy, but after this triumph, the Lord will in His turn gather His own people, and will reign and triumph over evil and will raise up from the tomb the buried Church, the prostrated Cross. . . " and the Head of the Heavenly Armies adds "Here is my Fiery Sword. I want to lend to the

friends of the Sacred Heart and offer them this sword for the fight, because the time is not far off, when all of you faithful people will have to take up the arms of Faith and Courage to fight against the relentless pursuit of hell and the vengeance of men."

What should I do



With that, Cap closed her folder and looked up from the lectern. "Are there any questions?" One person asked "What should I do?" It was a common question. In many cases, Cap could see the question in people's eyes even when they didn't ask it out loud. In

her case, she had moved to the country because it seemed like the right thing to do.

Dachas

Cap spoke about reading about how many Russian families survived the economic collapse of the 1980's by growing food at their dachas. About half the families in Russian have a country dacha, a small cottage and garden in the country where there is a big emphasis on growing one's own food. About 40% of the Russian food supply is grown in dacha gardens. Having a cottage in the country and growing one's own food is a strong cultural tradition. The cities are peppered with small corner shops selling an assortment of local vegetables and fruits.

Survival only possible in the country and small villages

"Von Werdenberg, the modern German mystic, predicted that in the wars and revolutions which were imminent, survival was only possible in the country and in small villages. (see appendix, Von Werdenberg.)

America devastated by war.

"Von Werdenberg also said that America would be devastated by war. In light of that, it might be a good idea to take a close look at the Russian Dacha movement. One of the driving forces behind the movement has been the threat of famine. Starvation is part of the Russian historical memory. People starved during The Revolution. Thirty million starved in the Ukraine during the Kulak collectivization of the early 30's. Peasants starved in the postwar years. The farm economy had lost millions of men, machinery and horses to the war. Mismanagement and drought also figured in. As a result, Russia was the one country which did not experience a postwar baby boom.

"Out of this experience has arisen a particularly Russian phenomenon, the dacha. The love of having a small cottage in the country, in which to retreat and grow food. We Americans may want to consider importing the Dacha culture. They love their gardens like Americans love their lawns. It would be good for our people and our country to have 120 million people growing food on small country plots.



Russia is mobilizing for war.

"I recently came across an article titled *Russia Mobilizes, America Sleeps*. The author said that the Russian system aims to mobilize everyone and everything for war. Meanwhile, western societies are concerned about consumption. Democratic societies are slow to mobilize. A war could be over before Americans could be mobilized. With the dachas, Russians are already prepared for war. Americans are not. We depend on the supermarket for food. In a catastrophe, famine in America may depend on whether or not we have a dacha culture or something like it. "

Suitcase Nukes

While Cap was traveling back to her farm, Colonel Goodman was also looking at the advent of war. The informal nature of the Officer's Club gave him to room to voice opinions which stood outside his conventional duties. On that night, he talked about secret armies.

The Russian government is working on a peace settlement. The military is angry that they are going to be downsized. One of my friends at the Pentagon is part of a team which keeps asking the question, what are they thinking. One of the scenarios is that right now, there is a group in Russia meeting at a table like this. One of them says 'It is our turn'. The military took it on the chin during Stalin's time. Stalin killed 90% of the officer corps. Then the Communist party was the ruling power. After perestroika, the KBG took over. So, the military is waking up to the idea

that they have the men and the material. They have a plan to invade Europe and a plan with the Chinese to defeat the US.

"There was a high-ranking Russian defector named Stanislav Lunev, who is now in the witness protection program. Lunev said that the Russians have a plan to plant suitcase weapons across the US. And to bring in hundreds of agents posing as businessman and tourists. The FBI wrapped up ten of them in 2010, but that was just the tip of the iceberg. They have gotten a

lot smarter since then. The Russians have a shadow people program. There are agents whose job it is to impersonate a

particular American. The shadow looks like the counterpart and practices hours each day speaking with the same accent. Each shadow has a team who helps the shadow to role play. The shadow and team, studies the counterpart and even listens to the counterpart. The team knows just about everything about their counterpart.

When the days comes that they get their orders, they will pick up their suitcases and drop them off at an assigned site. Sometimes it will be a box dropped into a trash can or left in a car or shipped next day on UPS. In some cases, the package will be fired from a mortar or flown from a drone.

The object will be to decapitate the civilian government and the military. To poison the water supply and the damage to food system. There will be three goals. One, to allow the Chinese to invade the west coast. Two, to distract the Americans from helping the Europeans and three, to bring America to its knees to sue for peace.

Quid Pro Quo

"My friend told me that when his team asks the question, what are the Russians thinking, one of the answers is that the Russians think they can win a certain kind of limited nuclear war. The team has named it Quid Pro Quo. The Russians think that there are well defined arenas where they can slug it out with nuclear weapons and not trigger an all-out nuclear war. For example, the Russians will use suitcase nukes against government buildings which gives us the right to hit their government buildings. They will hit our military bases with mortar and drones and we will hit their military bases with mortars and drones. They will not attack population centers en masse, and we will not attack population centers en masse. They will not use ICBM's, and we will not use ICBMs. Except that they have a couple thousand secret army personnel here in the US, and we do not have a similar force in Russia. So, the Russians are thrilled that they have the opportunity to initiate a customized war, in which they have a significant advantage. We will be forced to play by their rules, because it will not be in our interest to elevate the conflict into an unstoppable exchange of missiles.

"The American approach over the years has been deterrence through MAD, Mutual Assured Destruction. But, this theory has an Achilles heel. The weak spot is Quid Pro Quo. We are at a disadvantage. We are going to wake up and find that they have outfoxed us. They will be hitting us a hundred to one.

Mount Yamantau

Another Russian advantage is that they have an advanced system of underground complexes. The tallest mountain in the Southern Urals is Yamantau Mountain. Deep beneath the surface is a complex which covers an area the size of Washington inside the



Beltway. Yamantau was designed to survive a nuclear war. It has been built to resist direct nuclear hits, one after the other. A nuclear bunker buster can only penetrate about 50 ft into

granite. The Russians have constructed two entire cities over the site, known as Beloretsk 15 & 16, which are closed to the public, each with 30,000 workers.

Three hundred and seventy miles to the north is Kosvinsky Mountain, another nuclear bunker. Kosvinsky has been called the crown jewel of the Russian wartime command system.

Imagine if the two are connected by multiple rail links. We assume that the Yamantau complex is below Yamantau Mountain. What if it is not? What if they have built a city the size of Washington, and spread out it along 370 miles of underground rail road? One defense department study estimates that the Russians have spent six billion dollars on the project. And that the complex may consist of 400 square miles. That could be one mile wide and 400 miles long or they could honeycomb the mountain ten miles wide and 400 miles long. We think that there are some 200 secret, deep underground nuclear war-fighting sites in Russia. There is a congressman named Bartlett who has been studying Yamantau for years. He says it's very disquieting that the Russians are doing this massive construction.

The Chinese position

A week later, the advent of war hung in the air at the Officers Club. One of the officers said he had read a book about England in 1939. They knew war was coming. He said it reminded him of the current atmosphere in America. He looked at Hap and asked "what are the Chinese thinking?" Hap said that back in the 90's, the Secretary of Defense for China told a meeting of the Communist party that China would be forced to go to war with the US for a number of reasons. First, they needed Lebensraum, the room to expand; they had polluted their own country; Only America offered the amount of land they required; the Chinese were the superior race so they deserved it. Chinese navigators had discovered America before Columbus, so they were entitled to it. That speech was given long before the Chinese had accumulated enough money to buy into America.

The recent troubles in American had caused housing and land prices to drop by about ninety per cent in adjusted dollars, just as they had during the great depression. With the drop in prices, the Chinese could have purchased a considerable part of the best land west of the Mississippi.

An avalanche of individual Chinese investors were grabbing up large numbers of businesses and properties. In response, the government had placed capital controls on the flow of dollars, which slowed down the pace of purchases.

The Chinese government was demanding that they be able to swap their rapidly depreciating treasury bonds for property on the west coast and the western farmland. The US was dragging

its feet. The Chinese were furious. They felt that they had been swindled. They took the public position with the US government and with their domestic population that they were entitled to purchase property in America. The Chinese were demanding complete freedom to purchase farmland west of the Mississippi.

Chinese Dollars.

"The Chinese hold trillions of Treasury debt. The cumulative trade deficit is about ten trillion. There are a lot of American dollars being held in China. When a Chinese manufacturer flies in and buys a home for three million cash in one afternoon, that money is just the crumbs on the table.

The Chinese were in a position to purchase half of the large farms west of the Mississippi. The mortgages and loans were selling for pennies on the dollar. That is on top of the fact that prices were depressed. The Chinese were in a position to purchase the non-performing loans at a fraction of the cost of the property. For example, a wheat farm in Kansas might be recently valued at about a million dollars. But, because the weather had wrecked the crops for two years in a row, the farmer was bankrupt. Nobody wants to buy the farm at this time, because the seasons are unreliable. The auction value has dropped to about 100,000. But, the loans were worth less because they were nonperforming. The farm had 200,000 dollars of outstanding defunct loans. The loans could be purchased for 20,000 or less. That was true for many of the farms.

"In an orderly market, a buyer could take possession of the farm for about 20,000 dollars cash, maybe less if he leveraged his money. Do the math. The Chinese have trillions of dollars. They have enough dollars to purchase large tracts of prime American farmland. But, the U.S. will not allow it. Instead, the Chinese are watching their money go up in smoke.

"The Farm Bureau is working to flood farmers with emergency loans to allow them hang on. The massive money creation has further accelerated the drop in the value of the dollar. It is a financial clash. On the one hand, the Chinese are justified. They should be allowed to spend their dollars. On the other hand, the politicians say that the dollars are for buying goods, not land en masse. And the younger voters are sayings that money is a contract, and that they never agreed to selling America to the Chinese.

How would the war begin?

One of the new members asked Hap how war might begin. Hap said that he guessed that the Chinese would arrive on container ships, tourist ships, commercial aircraft, passenger aircraft, and as tourists. "On any given week, there about 200 container ships landing on the west coast.

That could easily rise to 800. Some of them carry 10,000 containers. That is a lot of room for men and material.

About 7,000 inbound passengers arrive each day from Asia. Last December, about 130,000 passengers arrived inbound from China. There is also Mexico and Canada. Commercial aircraft could be loaded with men and material. If the Chinese took over the airports in a surprise, they could bring in 100,000 men each day.

After the loss of California, the Chinese built extensive port and distribution facilities in Seattle.

I think that the Chinese could land a million men in the west. It would be formidable. The new member asked, "what will we do?" Hap answered that "First, we will cut off their supply lines. We will nuke the waters and nuke the air if we have to, but we will stop the flow of incoming troops and supplies. We will nuke the ports and airports and military bases in China. Then, we will have to slug it out.

Conference

Hap hosted a three-day conference at Cheyenne mountain with a couple dozen officers of his rank to exchange ideas on what seemed like an inevitable war. A speaker at one of the sessions was a general whose code name was Gruff. "The topic of my presentation is the Siege of Seattle. It seems that war is coming. If there is an invasion, we will cut them off. The Mexicans will cut them off in the south. And, the Canadians will cut them off in the north. We will nuke their ports and military bases. We will nuke their coastal waters to destroy their ships and coastal facilities. We will stop the flow of incoming troops and supplies.


We have amassed a supply of materials to grind away at them and wear them down. In the history of warfare, the defender always loses a siege. Once begun, the besieged troops are doomed. We will just start attacking them position by position. We will back them into a corner. There will be no break out. They will not have the supply lines."

As Gruff spoke, Hap recalled reading Julius Caesar's Commentaries on the Gallic War. Caesar described his Siege of the camp of the Gallic leader Vercingetorix. Hap thought it unexpected that in this modern age, that we would be using a tactic that went all the way back in history to the earliest cities. His professor used to say that to know the future of warfare, you had to know the past.

One of the attendees asked "What about the Americans who are in Seattle?" Gruff said that people will have to walk out. There will be little food or water.

Grain Map

In the Officers Club one evening a week later, one of the officers named Younger asked "So where is it going to be safe?" Hap pulled two maps from his brief case. The first was a white USDA map of the lower 48 states,



with the wheat production areas highlighted in green. The map showed a large green mass which covered the western three quarters of Kansas and spilled into Colorado and Oklahoma. There was another green area about a quarter as large in north central Montana, along the Canadian border, and a third smaller area in eastern Washington State. Younger said "So, this is where the wheat is."

Hap said that "the Chinese have decided to take over the land west of the Mississippi by purchase, or by force of arms. Plan A is to purchase western America peaceably. But, Plan B is to take it over in a surprise Pearl Harbor like move. They will not nuke the farmland. They need it to feed their people.

Hap pulled out another map. It showed Corn Production centered in Iowa and southern Minnesota. The green areas stretched from Illinois on the east to Nebraska on the west.

"If you put these two maps together, you will see the major food production areas of the US. These are the crown jewels of food production. These are the areas which the Chinese would like to take over intact. There is a case to be made that these areas are the least likely to be nuked.



When Cap arrived home

When Cap arrived home, a letter was waiting from her

proof reader, Cathy Jones. Jones had become interested in Cap's project and had done extensive reading on her own. Cathy wrote,

About the meteor impact that is supposed to cause a shaking, which would register 14 on the Richter scale.

Why is the big meteor not mentioned in Apocalypse? The Chapters which deal with the seventh trumpet and the seventh bowl describe thunder, lightning, voices, an earthquake and a great hail. The hail will consist of meteors which weigh one talent each, which is about a 100 pounds. And, Apocalypse says that the islands will flee and the mountains will disappear. ⁱ Is it reasonable to think that such a large meteor would go unmentioned?

Jeffrey Goodman, the archeologist, deduced that the earth will be struck by a 100-mile-wide meteor which will penetrate into the interior of the earth and explode. The heat released will cause the mantle to soften and melt. As a result, the mountain chains will sink and the earth will be level.

If the writer of Apocalypse goes to the trouble of writing about the thunder, lightning, voices, earthquake, hail, and mountains disappearing, why does he not mention something as big as a 100-mile-wide meteor? According to Goodman, the writer mentions one meteor in the first woe and four meteors in the second woe. That he does not mention a meteor in the third woe suggests that there may not be a 100-mile-wide meteor. The cause of the mountains disappearing would have be something else.

Angel touches Axis

What else would cause those conditions? Lucy gives the answer. The angel touches the axis of the earth and it wobbles.

If you build a sand castle in a baking dish and shake it, the sand will become level. Matthew says the heavens will be shaken. ⁱⁱ But, it is the earth which will wobble back and forth. The stars will appear to shift back and forth across the sky. This would cause a great earthquake.

Chapter 10 says that the writer was told to seal up what he had seen. People have wondered about the meaning of the "powers of the heavens will be shaken." It is difficult to imagine. But. Lucy explained. Mary showed her the angel touching the axis of the earth. The earth wobbled as a result.

Lucy was Mary's ambassador and Mary is God's ambassador. You could say that Lucy's description of the axis wobbling is the unsealing of Chapter 10. Which gets back to the core idea of the *Whole Truth about Fatima*. Which is that God wishes to reveal to men that all grace comes through Mary. And, He is angry that men are not submissive to His plan. As a result, He will pour out His wrath upon the planet. Goodman makes a good case that He has done this before. He illustrates that time and time again in speaking with Elijah, Isaiah, Samuel and in the psalms, God has punished the waywardness of past societies with comets.

I believe we will be privileged to witness the powers of the heavens being shaken. For your consideration, Cathy.

Flaming Lance

When Cap finished reading the letter, she folded it and tapped it on the table a couple times as she considered Cathy's ideas. What about the flaming lance? Sister Lucy wrote about the time in 1944 when she struggled to write down the secret. She felt the friendly hand of the Madonna upon her shoulder and then Sister Lucy was shown a vision. "The point of the flame-like lance which detaches, touches the axis of the earth and it [the earth] shakes: mountains, cities, towns and villages with their inhabitants are buried. The sea, rivers and clouds leave their bounds, they overflow, flood and drag with them into a whirlpool, houses and people in a number unable to be counted." Cap turned the idea over a couple times, and arrived at the point where she saw some agreement between the effects of Goodman's monster meteor and Lucy's flame like lance. The tip would touch the axis. which most likely means the northern pole. The impact would be large enough to disturb the rotation of the earth.

Velikovsky

Cap opened *Third Secret Reconstructed*. "There was a Russian named Immanuel Velikovsky. He wrote a book titled *Worlds in Collision*. The basic idea was that Jupiter ejected Venus, which passed near earth. The proximity produced an electromagnetic effect, which changed our orbit and axis, which in turn caused many catastrophes which were mentioned in ancient literature. His theory on Venus might have been incorrect, but he had intuited that the electromagnetic field of the earth might be altered by a close encounter with a comet or some other outside agent.

The Earth is a giant magnet. It functions like an electric motor. If a passing body had a strong enough electromagnetic field, it could cause the rotation of the earth to change. That would, of course, break up the crust of the earth.

Einstein knew Velikovsky. He had read his books and even sent them back with margin notes. Years later, he came back to them. Velikovsky's book was open on Einstein's desk when he died. I think that Einstein had found that Velikovsky had stumbled onto something.

Imagine what happens when a car, or bus, or subway slams on the breaks. People would go flying forward. This is what would happen in the Velikovsky scenario, except that we are moving forward at about 800 miles per hour. You don't see it because everything around you is moving at the same speed. If the core of the earth changed direction, there would be a big pile up.

Here is what Velikovsky said would happen in a near collision. "That under the impact of a force or the influence of an agent - and the earth does not travel in an empty universe - the axis of the earth shifted or tilted. At that moment, an earthquake would make the globe shudder. Air and water would continue to move through inertia; hurricanes would sweep the earth and the seas would rush over continents, carrying gravel and sand and marine animals, and casting them on the land. Heat would be developed, rocks would melt, volcanoes would erupt, and lava would flow from fissures in the ruptured ground and cover vast areas. Mountains would spring up from the plains and would travel and climb on the shoulders of other mountains, causing faults and rifts. Lakes would be tilted and emptied, rivers would change their beds; large land areas with all their inhabitants would slip under the sea. Forests would burn, and the hurricanes and wild seas would wrest them from the ground on which they grew and pile them, branch and root, in huge heaps."

Universal Bankruptcy

Cap considered that Velikovsky's vision of the past was a lot like Lucy's vision of the future.

What a year it would be. She remembered Melanie Porzat saying that there would be universal bankruptcy. Most of Cap's stocks had nearly disappeared. On the positive side, she had a house, food, water and a few coins.

Thunder and gunshot

A couple days later, Cap was sitting at her table having her morning coffee in early August. The corn in the field next door was ripe. She could hear a tractor starting its engine in the distance. A few seconds later, she felt the earth shake. Thirty seconds later she heard what sounded like a gunshot,

followed by thunder. Cap wondered if she would hear a nuclear explosion if one went off in St Louis or any of the cities nearby. A few seconds later, the ground shook again and she again heard the gunshot and thunder. The power went off.

That night Cap learned that the nearby nuclear power plant and the state capitol had been blown up. Cap had an orange job box in her garage, which she had turned into a Faraday cage. Inside were three EMP bags. In one was a short-wave radio. In another was a modified AM radio, and in a third was a crystal radio set and a hand crank generator. Neighbors came over at night to listen to the radio.

In the weeks which followed, events unfolded as Cap had forecast. The Russians invaded Europe in three wedges. EMP weapons exploded over the US and Canada. A Russian secret army attacked hundreds of American sites. The Chinese hit all western US military bases with a surprise first strike.

Ports.

The Chinese invaded the west coast of America. A flotilla of Chinese container ships landed, which were filled with troops not imports. Soldiers quickly took over the defenseless ports. Hundreds of ships followed.

Airports

The Chinese landed a succession of tourist planes filled with soldiers which took over the major western airports. Other planes carrying troops poured in behind. America wasn't prepared to resist an invasion.

Military Bases.

All the military bases were struck by a combination of suitcase weapons and drone delivered weapons. Each suitcase delivered about 14 kilotons, nearly the same explosive power as the Hiroshima bomb. A single bomb was enough to level most military

bases. Hangars, barracks, vehicles and airplanes were blown to pieces. Some of the pieces fell a mile or two away. In many cases, bases had been struck with two or three bombs.

Naval.

Along the new coast in Colorado and Arizona, naval bases were bombed. Nearly every ship was sunk or crippled. It was like Pearl Harbor a hundred times over. American ships were on fire everywhere across the globe. Just about everything on the surface had been destroyed. They were all vulnerable to nuclear weapons. All the U.S. military bases all over world were struck at the same time.

In a few minutes, ships had become obsolete. All the Russians and Chinese had to do was come close.

Cities.

Multiple suitcase nukes exploded in every city. Fuel depots were on fire. There was no fuel. Food distribution centers had been blown away by the hundreds. The stores were empty. Utilities had been struck. There was no water, electricity or natural gas. With no food, water, electricity or police protection, people began walking out of the cities.

Highways filled with hungry people.

It brought to mind a story which Lucy told. 'We went to the cave called Lapa do Cabeço. As soon as we got there, we prostrated on the ground, saying the prayers the Angel had taught us. After some time, Jacinta stood up and called to me: "Can't you see all those highways and roads full of people, who are crying with hunger and have nothing to eat?"

Cap spoke quietly to hear herself think. "There will be highways filled with hungry people."

The Binary star

Cap opened one of her folders. Years earlier she had written: "Most stars are binary stars. If the thing which is approaching us is a small star, it will pass us twice. Once on the way into our solar system. And, once on the way out. It is coming from deep space, where the gravity of the sun has been tugging upon it for thousands of years. It is now traveling toward the sun and picking up speed. It will slingshot around the sun and shoot back out again.

When will it pass us?

This begs the question, when will the star pass us on the way in, and when will it pass us on the way out? Jeffrey Goodman, who wrote *Comets of God*, believes that comets are prominent in Apocalypse. And, particularly in the Trumpets.

When the star passes us on the way in, a great shakeup will occur. "Thunders and voices and lightnings, and a great earthquake" are mentioned at the beginning of Chapter 8 of Apocalypse. This occurs before the First Trumpet.

Passes twice

If the star passes us twice, it will cause a great shakeup twice. If we look further down the road, we will see that the Seventh Trumpet brings on "lightnings, and voices, and an earthquake." Nearly the same words again. So, it is reasonable to think that the star passes us again during the Seventh Trumpet, on the way out of the solar system.

In the most likely scenario, the star will pass us in 2025. It will produce a great sign. And it will pass us again in 2032, the year before the Three Days Darkness.

Differences between the two encounters

Our first encounter with the star will be on the way into our solar system. Apocalypse says 'Thunders and voices and lightnings, and a great earthquake.' The second encounter with the star is on the way out. 'Lightnings, and voices, and an earthquake, and great hail.' The language is nearly the same. Except that in the first encounter, the emphasis is on the earthquake being a great earthquake. The emphasis in the second encounter is on hail, as in great hail. The hail would likely come from passing through the comet's tail.

High in the Sky

In the words of Apocalypse immediately following the Seventh Trumpet, there appeared a Great Sign. The woman will have the moon beneath her feet. Which means

that the sign will be above the path of the moon. The crown of twelve stars implies that the Sign will appear across the whole of the zodiac, across the whole sky. One will look up at the sky to see the great sign. So, the star will be high up in the sky.

The Path of the Star

If we look more closely at the Seventh Trumpet, there is a clue about the direction and the angle of the orbit of the star. Men will look up. If the Sign is high in the sky, then if follows that the star has come from below. It has not traveled the same plane as the planets. It came from below. It passed upward though the solar plane. It spent seven years in the northern hemisphere of the sky. Which means that it rose for three and a half years. Then, it slowed down and reach its apogee. And then it began to fall toward the sun for three and half years.

We will see it coming. Men will faint away. During the seventh year, which is the Seventh Trumpet, it will be falling toward the sun, maybe on our side of the sun. As it approaches the sun, it may even light up. The star will bring with it a train of material. Some small, some large and some very large.

The Seventh Bowl

In the Seventh Bowl, it is written 'No earthquake like it has ever occurred since mankind has been on earth.' 'God remembered Babylon the Great and gave her the cup filled with the wine of the fury of his wrath.'
